Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 610.1 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 52.4 %

Progress against these targets can be seen in the chart below:

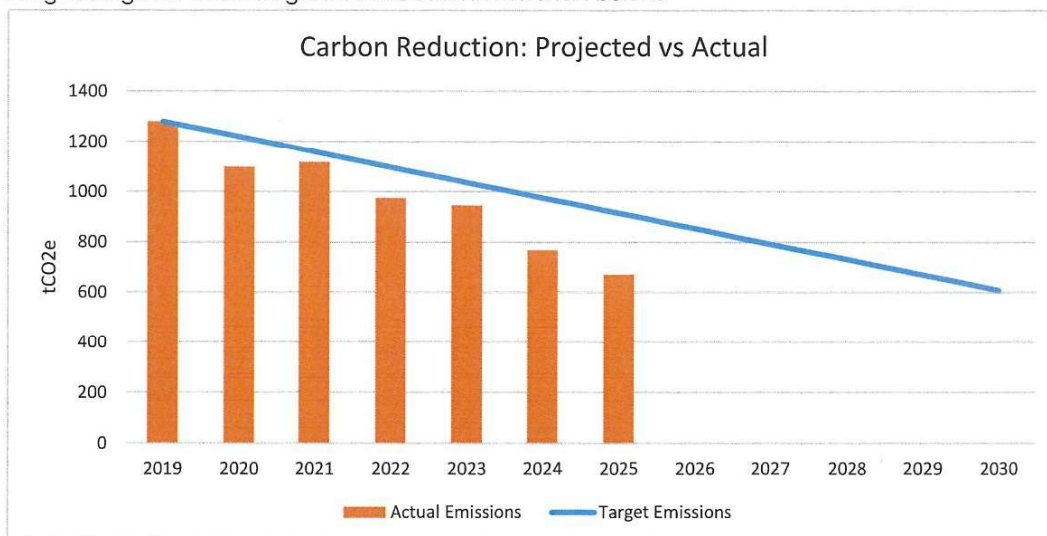


Chart shows Market based total

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Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2019 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 609.2 tCO₂e, a 47.6% reduction against the 2019 baseline.

- Power from renewable sources: MLL's HQ in Marlow, Office & warehouse in Silverstone, Data centre and Exchange providers are supplied with power from 100% renewable sources.
- New HQ premises in Marlow, appropriately sized to align with Hybrid working model.
- LED lighting in HQ in Marlow and Office & warehouse in Silverstone
- Telematics: MLL vehicles have telematics installed, which is key to monitoring drivers' behaviour and creating sustainable driving habits to optimise the efficiency of the vehicle.
- Hybrid working model: 20% of MLL staff are home based and we have an established hybrid working model, which reduces travel and vehicle use and the associated emissions.
- Waste disposal: Zero waste generated by MLL goes into landfill.
- Demand driven energy: Office heating is on a timer and sensor and communal lighting is on sensors.
- Business travel: Evaluate and, where possible, adopt means of reducing business travel, including continued use of video conferencing.
- Private vehicles: MLL's lease scheme exclusively offers fully electric vehicles.
- Lifecycle Analysis: Within our managed service offering, where practicable equipment is reused, repaired and remanufactured.
- Switch to EV: Conducted an EV trial for 1 vehicle in London

Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Complete the refresh, currently underway, of the MLL Core Network which will result in reduced numbers of devices and reduced power consumption.
- Manage the Supplier engagement plan to gain commitment from suppliers to reduce their emissions
- Start investing in nature based solutions
